

STEPS FOR COMPLETING YOUR HOUSE PORT

- 1. Decide on Size and Style of House Port by reviewing our MODELS & PRICES.
- 2. Check with local building department to verify requirements of our BUILDING SPECS & MATERIALS. Bring contractor if necessary.
- 3. Purchase property either through owner or local realtor.
- 4. Consult or hire a general contractor if you are not the owner/builder.
- 5. Visit our PURCHASE link with your professional to familiarize yourselves with the process.
- 6. Complete itemized Line-By-Line Worksheet.
- 7. Get construction estimate from contractor.
- 8. Begin securing construction loan if applicable.
- 9. Make deposit and sign Sales Contract [and return to House Port for purchase of the House Port Kit Package.]
- 10. After we, at House Port, receive funds, we will send you plans, the building manual and instructional DVD.
- 11. Obtain all building permits.
- 12. Finalize contract with contractor if applicable.
- 13. Prepare site.
- 14. Final payment and shipping charges are due after foundation is completed.
- 15. We will deliver the House Port components to the site or closest drop-off location.
- 16. Construction of House Port: Line-By-Line Worksheet.
- 17. House Warming Party.
